

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this price list for a standardised set of products and services.

This is to help you think through your options and make choices and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors.

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral directors charges only)

This is a funeral where a family and friends have a ceremony event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (Within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care

Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)

Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) **

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial, the burial fee* in this local area (Lancaster City Council)

For a new grave, you will also need to purchase the plot. For an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.
